



NCR BRAC Transition MTF Census 2011




Staff Orientation and Training



- Current Staff in JOA
 - DACH, WRAMC, NNMC, JTF CAPMED Staff
 - 4 Phases
 - Transitional Orientation
 - 0.5 Days
 - General Facility Orientation
 - 0.5 Days
 - Department/Clinical Orientation
 - 3-4 Weeks
 - Safety/Competency Validation
 - 1-2 Weeks
 - Assumes existing competency
 - No New Skills
 - Focus: Orientation, Familiarization, Team-Building
- New Staff
 - PCS/New Hiring Action
 - 3 Phases
 - Newcomer's Orientation
 - 5 Days
 - Department/Clinical Orientation
 - 3-4 Weeks
 - Safety/Competency Validation
 - 1-2 Weeks
 - Assumes basic skill set but no documented competency
 - Focus: Integration, Skill Acquisition, Competency Assessment, Team-Building




